Do's

- Water your natural Christmas tree daily. A dry tree is a serious fire hazard.
- Inspect lights, cords and decorations. Discard any that are damaged or worn.
- Follow manufacturer guidelines for the number of incandescent (non-LED) strings of lights strung together.
- Turn off all decorations before leaving home or going to bed. Consider installing an outlet timer to do this job for you.
- Keep decorations at least three feet away from any open flame.
- Keep cords out of walkways to avoid tripping hazards.

Don'ts

- Leave space heaters unattended when in use.
- Plug extension cords into each other.
- 3. Run cords under carpets, rugs, furniture, or out of windows.
- Overload outlets. Plugging multiple cords into an outlet can increase risk of fire or electric shock.
- 5. Use a frayed cord.
- Leave an indoor/outdoor fire or candle unattended.
